Personal Achievement – *Mortgage Professional of the Year*

Deadline

All entries must be submitted online no later than 5 p.m. on Feb. 3, 2023. After this time, entries are subject to a \$25 late fee per entry.

Cost

The entry fee for a Personal Achievement submission is \$85 per entry. Companies will be invoiced by the HBA for submitted entries. No refunds will be given.

Eligibility

- Your employer must be a member of the Home Builders Association of St. Louis and Eastern Missouri.
- Information provided on the application must be for sales activities between January 2022 and December 2022.

Judging

Personal Achievement submissions are judged on a 100-point system. Should the situation occur where there is only one entry in a Personal Achievement category, 70 points would qualify as a winning entry without competition. The HBA reserves the right to eliminate any category due to insufficient entries or where the quality of work does not warrant a winner. There are no ties in a category. A definitive winner will be picked by the judges.

Applicant is judged on number/dollar volume of new homes closings (15 points), job duties related to the home building industry (10 points), approach to client relations/follow up (15 points), market research (10 points), unusual challenges faced and overcame (15 points), professional development (10 points), community involvement (10 points) and home builder/salesperson recommendation (15 points).
